## 2018 Two Tons

**Appellation:** San Diego County, Warner Springs

**Vineyard:** Orrin Vineyard,  
3300 feet, Alluvial decomposed granite

**Varieties:** 50% Syrah, 50% Zinfandel,  
self-rooted

**Harvest:** Syrah on August 23, 2018  
Zinfandel on September 5, 2018

**Fermentation:** Wild Yeast and Malolactic

**Alcohol:** 12.0%

**Production:** 32 cases

### Tasting Notes

Glou glou heaven. Juicy black cherry, blackberry, pomegranate and black pepper. Recommend serving slightly chilled.

### Winemaker's Notes

Clusters de-stemmed into small open-top bins. Whole berry, wild yeast and malolactic fermentation. Twice daily punch downs. Pressed after five days. Free run and late press fractions used. Fermentation finished in small Flex tanks. Racked off gross lees after four months. No acidulation or other "corrections". Cold settled, and bottled unfiltered on 2/9/2019.
